

Cellular Phone Policy  
(beginning 2008-2009)

Students will not be allowed to possess or use a cellular phone during the school day. This includes during break/tutorial period or during lunch break. The only exception to this rule is that a student will be allowed to take a cell phone with him/her if the student leaves on an extracurricular trip before school is out for the day. If a cellular phone is seen on a student's possession during the school day, it will be taken up by school officials.

The following penalties will be enforced before the student regains possession of his/her phone.

1<sup>st</sup> Offense---phone will be taken up and kept in the office for one week

2<sup>nd</sup> Offense---phone will be taken up for one week and student must pay \$10 fine to receive the phone

3<sup>rd</sup> Offense---phone will be taken up for two weeks and student's parent(s) must come to school and pay \$15 fine to receive phone

Each subsequent offense---phone will be taken up for two weeks and student's parent(s) must come to school and pay an additional five dollars above the previous fine to receive phone
